3D Printing and Scanning workflows for Removable Dentures

In this lecture, we will discuss navigating scanning and 3D printing workflows in the various scenarios that one may encounter in the denture-providing practice. This will include scanning of models and impressions for complete, immediate/surgical, combination cases, and partial dentures.
