COURSE OVERVIEW

This lecture and hands-on course focuses on Vital Pulp Therapy (VPT) as a predictable, evidence-based approach to **preserving pulp vitality in young and mature permanent teeth**.

General dentists are often the first clinicians to encounter deep caries and pulp exposures. In many cases, these teeth can be preserved with vital pulp therapy; however, due to uncertainty in diagnosis, case selection, and technique, patients are frequently referred multiple times or undergo unnecessary root canal treatment—often at a very young age.

This course is designed to bridge that gap by empowering clinicians with the knowledge and **confidence to make the right decision at the right time**.

Participants will gain a clear understanding of:

- ✓ Why preserving the pulp matters biologically and clinically
- ✓ When vital pulp therapy is indicated—and when it is not
- ✓ How modern materials and techniques improve outcomes

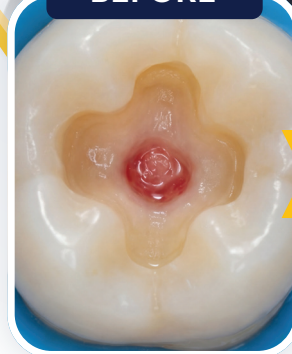
