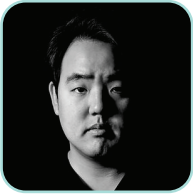

## Secrets Revealed 2026: Lifelike Zirconia Restorations

This lecture focuses on the clinical and technical decisionmaking process required to achieve lifelike esthetic outcomes in zirconia restorations. Rather than emphasizing isolated techniques, the presentation centers on case analysis, cut-back design, and layering strategy, guiding participants through a structured approach to achieving natural results.

A significant portion of the lecture covers a range of esthetic expression approaches in zirconia, from stain and glaze techniques to full facial layering, including refined micro layering strategies. Through real clinical cases, the session covers how cut-back design and layering decisions relate to characterization and overall esthetic outcomes, while providing clear rationale behind each step.

This presentation is intended for dental technicians and clinicians seeking a structured and predictable approach to zirconia restorations, with an emphasis on consistent esthetic results achieved through thoughtful planning and controlled artistic execution.
